The clinical pathway option for certification will expire on **December 31, 2013**, after which only the fellowship option will be allowed. The American Osteopathic Conjoint Committee of Undersea and Hyperbaric Medicine's (AOCUHM) 2012 Spring CAQ Examination will be given at the **American Osteopathic College of Occupational and Preventive Medicine's Mid-Year Educational Conference**. The conference will be held March 13-18, 2012 at the Vinoy Renaissance Hotel in St. Petersburg, Florida.

**To be eligible to take the examination, a candidate will have to meet the following criteria:**

1. Have graduated from an AOA accredited college of osteopathic medicine.
2. Have satisfactorily completed a one-year AOA approved internship.
3. Have satisfactorily completed a one-year AOA or ACGME approved hyperbaric medicine fellowship, or completed a clinical pathway. The clinical pathway consists of:
  - a. Completion of a 40 hour basic course in Undersea and Hyperbaric Medicine and all coursework must be in person, NOT online.
  - b. A two-year period of time in which he or she spent a minimum of 25% of his or her time in the practice of Undersea and Hyperbaric Medicine.
  - c. Documentation of supervision of at least 500 treatments.  
(please see the application for additional requirements and details).
4. Be (and remain) a member in good standing of the American Osteopathic Association or the Canadian Osteopathic Association.
5. Hold primary board certification from a participating certifying board of the Bureau of Osteopathic Specialist.
6. Hold a wholly unrestricted valid state license to practice osteopathic medicine.
